Desire to work and live in the out of doors for 2 months during the summer.

Good organizational, communication and leadership skills

Emotional maturity, good moral character and integrity

Willingness to learn from and make use of trainings

Commitment to the value and benefits of outdoor experiential education in meeting campers social and physical needs

General Responsibilities:

Teach 3 one-hour classes each day, to a high standard

Lead a tribe and fulfill all responsibilities

Spend at least 1 week in the cabin area

Assist in camper supervision

Head a table at all meals

Assist in implementing and planning for all camp recreations/programs

Attend and participate in All 4-H Staff training and HC4H Staff Training

Arrive at camp prepared for the week at 12:00 Noon on Sunday till 12:00 Noon Saturday

You may take 1 night off per week (6 PM to 12 AM)

Follow, model and enforce all camp rules, policies and procedures

Participate in all camp programs

Be a positive role model for campers and staff
